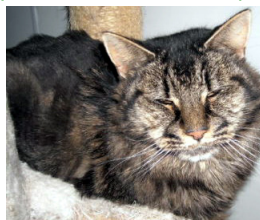

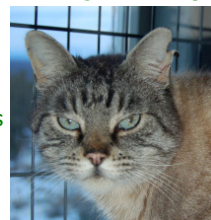

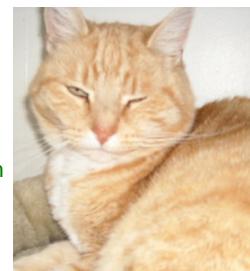

Special needs We have many special needs cats, most just needing a safe and loving home. Call or email us for more information.

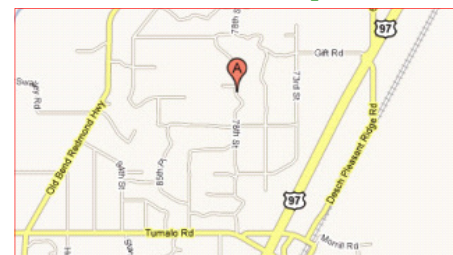
Senior Citizens Seniors aged 55 and over may adopt an adult cat at no cost to them, upon application approval. Donations are always appreciated.
